Our child safe organisation prioritises the safety and wellbeing of each child. We strongly advocate and promote a culture of safety, security and believe that all children have the right to be heard. We strive to protect children from harm, respect their dignity and safeguard their wellbeing by embracing a shared commitment to child safety, protection, and welfare.

Our service believes that all children are competent and capable learners, we embrace inclusiveness within our play-based curriculum and provide children with the freedom of choice which is strongly supported by our indoor/outdoor program. We offer a wide variety of age-appropriate learning opportunities and a range of easily accessible resources, as we believe this supports children to learn about the world around them as they investigate, experiment, collaborate and learn at their own pace.

We believe children gain a positive self-identify when they are given the opportunity to learn and explore within a familiar, warm and inviting setting. Our indoor environment is welcoming and reflective of our children and families. We believe in displaying the children's creative artwork as it instils a strong sense of being, belonging and becoming.
